A. The lustful Man (Luke 12:16-21)

Mat 13:12

1. His decision – “I will pull down my barns and build greater”
2. His desire – “take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry”
3. His death – “this night thy soul shall be required of thee”
  - a. Things that were left Behind
  - b. Things that lay Before

B. The lost Man (Luke 16:19-31)

1. His Story on earth
  - a. His fashion – “clothed in purple and fine linen”
  - b. His food – “fared sumptuously every day”
  - c. His fence – “laid at his gate”
2. His Story in eternity
  - a. His pains Were Real – “torments...tormented...tormented...torment”
  - b. His prayers Were Rejected – “send Lazarus”

C. The likeable Man (Luke 18:18-30)

1. The Challenge – “what shall I do to inherit eternal life?”
2. The Charge – “sell all that thou hast...and come, follow me”
3. The Choice – “he was very sorrowful: for he was very rich”
