

XXVII. Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-10)

A. He Was set - "chief among the publicans, and he was rich" (v. 2)

1. He Had a position

2. He Had prosperity

B. He Was short - "he was little of stature" (v. 3)

1. He Climbed Up (v. 4)

2. He Came Down (v. 6)

C. He Was seeking - "he sought to see Jesus" (v. 3) *In 55:6*

1. Because of the Crowd - "all the people...gave praise to God" (18:48) 43

2. Because of Curiosity - "who he was"

D. He Was a sinner - "a man that is a sinner" (v. 7)

1. Describes His Condition

2. Displays Their Condemnation

3. Divulges Their Criticism - "he [Jesus] was gone to be a guest with a man that is a sinner"

E. He Was sincere - "I give to the poor...I restore him fourfold" (v. 8)

1. His Call - "Lord" *Ro 10:13*

2. His Commitment - "I give...I restore"

3. His Compassion - "to the poor...from any man"

F. He Was Saved - "This day is salvation come to thy house" (v. 9)

1. This day *II Cor 6:2*

2. This house *Acts 16:31*
