

XV. Philip – Not the Apostle (Acts 6, 8, 21)

A. Philip the deacon (Acts 6:1-7)

1. He was a good man – “of honest report” 1 Peter 2:12 II Cor. 13:7
2. He was a godly man – “full of the Holy Ghost”
3. He was a gifted man – “full...of wisdom” Prov. 4:7 9:10

B. Philip the disciple (Acts 8) A preacher

1. He Preached to the Samaritans and many believed (v. 5-8, 12)
2. He Preached to Simon who may have believed (v. 9-11, 13-24)
3. He Preached to the Secretary of the Treasury who most definitely believed (v. 25-40)

C. Philip the dad (Acts 21:8-14)

1. His fame – “Philip the evangelist”
2. His faithfulness
3. His family – “the same man had four daughters”
 - a. He Raised his daughters to be moral – “virgins”
 - b. He Raised his daughters to be Spiritual – “which did prophesy”
