 - a. Her region - "And he must needs go through Samaria" (v. 4)
 - b. Her race - "the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans" (v. 9)
 - c. Her religion - "Our fathers worshipped in this mountain" (v. 20)
2. She was a Stranger (Luke 17:16-18)
3. She was a Sinner - "thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband" (v. 18)

1. She had an incomplete understanding of Water (v. 10-15) *I Cor. 2:14*
2. She had an incomplete understanding of Wickedness (v. 16-18)
 - a. Jesus wanted to Convict her of sin - "Go, call thy husband"
 - b. The Woman wanted to Conceal her sin - "I have no husband"
 - c. Jesus Confronted her sin - "he whom thou now hast is not thy husband"
3. She had an incomplete understanding of Worship (v. 19-20)
